Launched in July 2013, the relatable humor of Fowl Language Comics was soon after featured on websites such as Upworthy, BuzzFeed, HuffPost Parents, Pop Sugar Moms, Bored Panda, Awkward Family Photos and countless other humor and parenting blogs. And thanks to more than 1,100,000 fans on social media, including Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and Tumblr, Fowl Language continues to grow in popularity at a rapid pace.

In the early Fall of 2015 a selection of his cartoons on Upworthy went super-viral, becoming the 5th most shared content on all of Facebook, world-wide, that year. Soon after, the first of his 3 books, *Welcome to Parenting* was published by Andrews McMeel, followed by *The Struggle is Real* the following year. His 3rd book, *Winging It: The Art of Imperfect Parenting* will be released in October 2019
