

Speaking

My love affair with public speaking started with the Dwight Takamine Leadership Program in the 6th grade where we learned how to facilitate meetings. Eventually, I grew into my role as a leader, teacher, and was brought back as a keynote speaker on numerous occasions. Since then, I've been asked to deliver the keynote address for conferences, celebrations, and virtual events.

Through the Miss Hawai'i program, I traveled the country inspiring school-aged children with my story, and this is also when I started to serve as Master of Ceremonies. I've hosted events in every county in Hawai'i, in front of thousands of attendees, and at world class venues such as the Maui Arts & Cultural Center and the Hawaii Convention Center. Among the hundreds of events that I've helped to guide are Shep Gordon's 25th Anniversary New Year's Eve Concert, Shane Victorino's Celebrity Dinner and his Mahalo Maui Reggae Concert, the Miss Hawaii Pageant, the ACE Shootout with Steve Young on the Golf Channel, and the Hawai'i Food & Wine Festival.

As a 15-year veteran of broadcasting and award-winning journalist I've learned a lot about the media industry. Over the years, things have shifted and changed with the addition of social media. I used to get funny looks in the newsroom when I talked about Facebook and Instagram, but when we started Hawaii News Now's Facebook page, the head of marketing came to me asking for help sending fans their way (they now have more than 1 million followers).

I have served as a social media consultant for the Maui Food Bank, and large media companies in Hawai'i including Pacific Media Group and KITV4 Island News. I enjoy leading workshops on the topic and teaching others the skills they need to succeed.

Additionally, people constantly ask me how to get on the news, how to present themselves, how to prepare for a media interview, how the equipment works, how to develop their story, etc... I can help you with that - because it's my job! I have insider knowledge that I'm happy to share.




